PARENT'S/SPECTATOR'S CODE OF CONDUCT:

1. Do not force an unwilling child to participate.
2. Encourage your child to play by the rules.
3. Turn defeat into victory by helping your children work towards skill improvement and good sportsmanship. Do not ridicule, criticize or yell at your child or any other child for making a mistake or losing a competition.
4. Children learn by example. Applaud good play by your team as well as the opposing team.
5. Do not publicly question the officials' judgment or integrity.
6. Recognize the value and importance of officials and volunteer coaches. They give of their time and resources to provide recreational activities for your child.
7. Do not argue with other parents/spectators or coaches over things that happen on the field. Derogatory comments and taunting (verbal or physical) directed at coaches, players and/or spectators from any team will not be tolerated (Violent Fan's Law; NJS.2C:12-1).
8. Parents are responsible for supervising siblings during practice sessions and all games. YOU are responsible for sibling's safety. Parents must keep all siblings off the fields and make sure they do not damage or disturb Borough or school property.
9. Do not drop your child off for practices and games unless your coach is present.
10. Coaches are NOT babysitters. If you cannot be there at the designated pick-up time, you must make arrangements for your child to be picked up on time by another parent.
11. Does not drink alcoholic beverages (Borough Ordinance 3-8.1) and/or smoke/chew tobacco products anywhere on the Recreation fields or facilities (NJ Smoke Free Air Act).

PLAYER'S CODE OF CONDUCT:

1. Try your best in every game to win within the rules and proper sportsmanship.
2. No swearing, foul language, fighting, or disrespect will ever be tolerated toward your officials or coaches.
3. Never argue the official's decision.
4. Cooperate with your coaches and teammates; be a *team player* - this is a team sport. No ball hogging or individual glory.
5. Be respectful to your opponents both in victory and defeat.
6. Learn from your mistakes; work hard in practice to improve your skills and decision-making.
